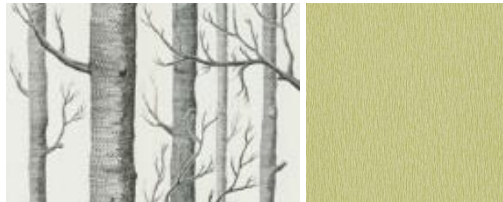


Using the elegant and contemporary design scheme created by EVCS. The involvement of stDES was to develop the design scheme and create the interior architecture for the project. Originally office space in a traditional glass box building, the site was converted into an open plan dining space catering for a variety of airport staff and aircrew in transit. With seating inside and out there was no shortage of comfortable spaces for groups or individuals to eat, meet or just pass the time. garden, involved moving boundary fences and taking up carpark but provided an invaluable contribution to the restaurant as a whole. Security, privacy, noise and wind-shear were important considerations in particular for the outdoor spaces, whilst creating a fire-box

surrounding the cooking areas, using fire shutters linked into the fire alarm and PA systems of the airport, were equally vital. Split level ceilings provided a more intimate space away from the windows and provided the much needed space above the ceilings for services without compromising the abundant natural light gained from the full height windows. Used all day through and all year round the incumbent caterers were able to provide great food in a great setting.
